OUR STORY

Bayfair started back in 1935 in the hearts of five families, who began a Sunday school work in a cottage on the west side of Frenchman's Bay. This group gave birth in later years to a small Church by the name of Dunfair Baptist Church.

Dunfair Baptist Church prospered over the years and in October of 1956 was accepted into the Fellowship of Evangelical Baptists Churches of Canada.

In 1961, a small group of people started meeting at Bay Road School and called themselves Bay Ridges Church.

Bayfair Baptist Church was born in 1970 with the amalgamation of Dunfair and Bay Ridges.







SEASONS OF GROWTH

Over the following years, the Lord blessed Bayfair Baptist Church in many ways including several building projects. Also, numerous short term mission trips were organized and completed to areas throughout the world. Bayfair had a growing involvement in reaching the world as it's mission commitment grew.

Bayfair Daycare was launched and has grown through the years to be one of the region's largest and most respected daycare facilities.

In more recent years, we have become a more diverse congregation with a love for the truth of God's Word and a clearer understanding of God's grace and love for mankind.

In 2017, Bayfair transitioned from a Deacon Led leadership model to an Elder Led model and are trusting in the Lord to bless His church, as the Elders seek God's will for the next 50 years of ministry.

In May of that same year, David Carter accepted the position of Lead Pastor. Pastor David had a passion for sharing the Word of God at every opportunity and began to build relationships within the community. His expositional style of preaching placed a high priority on scripture as the ultimate source for truth. In April 2023, David Carter was called to be the Lead Pastor of Bramalea Baptist Church.

Love

These gifts might look different depending on each individual's strengths and skillset.


OUR COMMUNITY
