POSITION TITLE: Lead Pastor

Duties and Responsibilities:

Primary:

<u>Special Services</u> - The Pastor, in conjunction with other staff members, should officiate at special services such as, but not limited to, weddings and funerals and other special services as from time to time occur in church life.

Representation - The Pastor will be the primary representative of Greenfield Park Baptist Church to other ministries and bodies as required.
