ABOUT OUR CHURCH

Welcome to North Broadway Baptist Church in Tillsonburg Ontario. We are a community of Christ-followers who long to glorify God and edify others. We exist to seek God, serve others and share Jesus. We are intentional about welcoming and ministering to each person who walks through our doors and as a growing body of believers, we are eager to expand our gospel centered ministries to reach all corners of our community and around the world.

The church facilities are located on a busy corner in Tillsonburg. We are currently renovating the church auditorium to better meet the needs of today's ministry. The renovation project, called "Impact Tomorrow Today", has been a powerful reminder that we have the honour and sacred duty to reach and disciple the next generation for Christ. These changes have created a fresh excitement amongst our congregation. While we remember our rich history of proclaiming the Word of God for many generations, we also eagerly anticipate what God will do in our midst in the future.

Our church is led by a board of dedicated deacons who are unified in their love for God and their vision for His church. We have a passionate staff who are committed to serving the Lord with their time and talents. In addition to lead pastor, our staff positions include a children's director, worship director, and office administrator.

We are a church with a heart for missions as evidenced by our support for many who carry the gospel around the world. Groups and individuals from the congregation also regularly go on short term mission trips. We love getting reports from these trips and from our missionaries that reinforce that God is at work in all parts of the world.



With many young families in our congregation our youth and children's ministries are thriving. Both Kids Church and our weekly Kid's Night Out program have experienced great growth. We have been blessed to build strong relationships with some of the other evangelical churches in the area, collaborating on programs such as VBS and various youth events. Our youth meet weekly at the Youth Unlimited (YFC) centre in town where God provides frequent opportunities for growth through fellowship and community outreach. We are looking to God's leading for other areas in which we can grow these ministries.

We offer both men's and women's Bible studies as well as life groups for adults. These groups regularly meet to identify and minister to one another and to the special needs of our church family through the guidance of God's Word and the leading of the Holy Spirit. We also offer a weekly support group, Celebrate Recovery, to address needs both within our church family and the community at large, maintaining a focus on Jesus as Healer.



A large part of the growth NBBC has experienced in recent years is a result of God's promise to believers to work all things together for good. Out of the isolation that many experienced during the Covid-19 pandemic, God has given us a new area of continued opportunity in allowing our online ministry to flourish. Our services continue to be frequently viewed online by those unable to attend in person.

Tillsonburg is a town of approximately 20,000 people in Oxford County in southwestern Ontario. It is primarily a rural community, but it has recently seen a lot of growth, with several new subdivisions being developed around town. Tillsonburg is unique in that it has two communities built solely for seniors. Our population is becoming more ethnically diverse, and our mission field becoming more varied.



Tillsonburg offers a balance between small-town community support and the exciting feeling of metropolitan growth. While providing stability for those in retirement, it also offers many well-developed recreational programs and facilities for all generations. Specific Duties:

Vision and Leadership

- Pray and plan for the present and future regarding vision, mission, goals and strategies
- Support church staff, volunteers and church ministries in conjunction with the deacons board
- Provide leadership development for board, staff and volunteers

Sunday Services

- Prepare and preach Biblical sermons
- Oversee and communicate service calendar and planning in conjunction with deacons board and staff

Church Outreach

- Be actively involved and develop outreach events and activities in conjunction with the outreach team
- Oversee welcome ministries for newcomers
- Support online ministry
- Support missions emphasis in the community and abroad

Discipleship

- Develop and lead in discipleship
