THE NEED

The spiritual needs in Ontario and Anglophone Québec are enormous. **Canada is the new missions field.**

FEB Central's population is a staggering 15 million people and it is estimated that 95% of our Region is without Christ. This represents half of the population of Canada.

We see the need all around us. The percentage of God-denying Canadians has doubled from six per cent of the population in the 1970s to 13 per cent, with about one in four Canadians saying they're inclined to reject religion. In many areas, people have not rejected the gospel; they have never heard the gospel.

THE ANSWER

To meet these vast spiritual needs, **we must respond by planting new churches** here in Ontario and Anglophone Québec. For years, we have been planting churches across the globe through mission agency partnerships, as well as in our region. But we must do more. We must aggressively plant more churches to reach our own mission field at home.

C. Peter Wagner said, "Planting new churches is the most effective evangelistic methodology known under heaven."

Tim Keller says, "Strange as it may seem, the planting of new churches in a city is one of the very best ways to revitalize many older churches in the vicinity and renew the whole body of Christ."

Ed Stetzer says, "Our churches need to be actively and consistently training and sending out planters... ..If established churches took this seriously and recognized their responsibility to be a part of a church multiplication movement, we would see a huge shift in North America for the sake of the Gospel."

OUR RESPONSE

In the past four years, God has enabled FebCentral to plant **28 new churches** along with the support, training, and resources to help these new churches flourish. But there's more work to do.

We are committed to planting a minimum of 21 new churches by 2020, with a vision for creating a multiplying movement of churches planting churches that will shape the future of our Region.

Today, **we are excited to introduce our new FEB Central Church Planting Advancement Foundation** that will accelerate this multiplication, not just for the next few months or years but for decades. This investment will help spark and sustain church planting for decades that will change lives for eternity.
