That summer Christians in and around the Sarnia area were revived in their faith, families were united in Christ, and many people trusted Jesus as their Lord and Saviour.

Out of this exciting time, Temple Baptist Church emerged. A group of eight members trusted God for a church and before long, He provided. Today, more than 85 years later, the legacy continues...

We are a church of over 500 people from all walks of life.

- Lead the ministry team in the fulfilling of their day-to-day ministry responsibilities.
- Ensure the operational readiness of the church through oversight of the support staff.
- Participate in our weekly worship services.
