THE WEST HIGHLAND BAPTIST CHURCH STORY

On June 2, 1972, a group of concerned Christians met for the first time to pray together about the spiritual needs of people on the West Mountain and establishing a new church to meet those needs. This became a weekly prayer gathering and with the encouragement of other Fellowship Baptist Churches in the Hamilton area Sunday morning worship services began on October 1, 1972.

In February 1973, Brian Baxter was appointed as the church's first pastor and under his leadership the church grew necessitating a move to the Terryberry Library in the fall of that same year to house the evening services. A new worship centre on the corner of Garth and Limeridge Roads was dedicated on Sunday, June 8, 1975.

With the arrival of a new pastor, Ian Kirby-Smith in 1978, the new building was soon full, and a balcony was opened to provide more space for the growing congregation.

In November 1982, Lambert Baptist was called to serve as pastor. Stimulated by an aggressive program of visitation, solid Bible teaching and a progressive Sunday School, significant growth took place

requiring two morning worship services in early 1985. In January 1997, Deric Bartlett became the new Senior Pastor, and the church entered an 8-year period of unprecedented growth.

In January 2008, John Mahaffey began his ministry as Lead Pastor. In 2009, West Highland's Ministry Team and Elders Team, under Pastor John's leadership, developed Vision 20/20, a ministry development plan that would expand and fully train new staff as well as foster richer relationships with each other, our community and Jesus Christ.

In October 2016, we celebrated the grand opening of our new Worship and Ministry Centre. The additional 30,000+ square feet provide us with space to enhance fellowship, ministry, worship and outreach to our growing community and city.

The year 2022 was the church's 50th anniversary. Pastor John retired in June of 2023, and Pastor Jamie Strickland became our Lead Pastor in June 2024.

West Highland remains committed to making disciples of Jesus within our immediate community on the West Mountain and beyond.
